## **Breaking New Ground**

You and I helped make history to do the first ever "National Sunday School Children's Festival" here in Fji, tying it into the National Conference of the Assemblies of God. In the past the National Conference (General Council held once every two years) only involved the pastors. We partnered in vision with the national leadership to make the General Council here an event that not only challenges and encourages pastors in their vision and ministry, but that reaches out to equip whole families.

**Thanks to your faithful** support and prayer, and help from BGMC and Good New Crusade Fund we saw over 400 children from all around Fiji enjoy 4 days worth of games, snacks, and challenging programs in the capital city of Suva.

**Programs that challenged** the kids to be born again, know who the Holy Spirit is, and equipping programs that taught them how to lead a friend to Christ and pray through in salvation.

We are following this up in October with an outreach to over a thousand school children in Nausori that includes training for the local churches to be able to disciple these children.

I asked Pastor Singh, the lead pastor we are partnering with about the training, "Would you like us to just focus on who the Holy Spirit is and the Baptism of the Holy Spirit for kids, or do we need to also cover how to bring a child into a personal relationship with Christ and be born again?"

**His reply was**, "Pastor, before you came here, we just taught the kids Bible stories. You are bringing this whole new thing of children being born again. Please train us in that as well."



Delivering food packs to mountain villages and taking vehicles on ferry boat rides across the ocean to other islands wears parts and tires down.


